

Step 1: Client Setup

- 1. Click Tools.
- 2. Select "Management Item Editor".



- 2. Highlight desired Project and click "OK".







Step 2: Populate Management Items

- Start at top with "Grower" and populate each "Management Item" with all potential sub "items" that are relevant to the instance. Must have Grower, Farm, Field, Product, People for CEBIS.
 Recommendation for your records is to populate Vehicle, Implement, Year.
- Select "Add New" if sub "item" desired does not exist. New items cannot be added in CEBIS.

Step 2: Populate "Resources"

1. Start at left with "Client" and populate each "Resource" with all potential sub "items" that are relevant to the instance. Must have Client, Farm, Field, Person, Commodities for CEBIS. New items cannot be added in CEBIS.



Step 2: Populate "Management Items" Continued

- Product, Operation, and
 Operational Instance
 "Management Items" must
 populate sub "items" with
 parameters relevant to the
 instance. For example, if the
 product is Alfalfa and it does not
 exist in the Product list, the item
 would have to be populated using
 Add New.
- 2. All remaining "Management Items" are instance specific and must be populated without generic information.








Step 2: Populate "Resources" Continued

- Click "Resources" and select "Commodities" to enter in crop type planned to harvest.
- Within "Commodity Properties", change Units to your preference for measurement. Example: ton or bushel.

Note: For crops such as Alfalfa with multiple harvests. It is recommended that a commodity is created for each harvest. Example: Alfalfa 1st Cutting, Alfalfa 2nd Cutting, etc.











- 2. Select "Attribute Editor".




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Step 3: Assign Commodities to Field


Step 2: Close CEBIS card slot cover

 Cover must be closed for card to register in CEBIS.



Step 4: Select working position parameters

 Check "Working Position" for headland management. If feeder house is above set position, recording stops. Learn working position when changing heads.









 Check your language, units, date/time, etc. to ensure you select the proper recording data.




Step 7: Enter Work Data Management

 Using the CEBIS rotary dial, scroll to the Mapping icon and click Rotary Dial.




Step 6: Begin CEBIS job setup

1. Select "Deal with the work record".







Step 9: Begin CEBIS job setup


- Click "Create a work record".
- Select the Farm, Field, Crop, and Operator specific to the instance (Your options were populated in the software, this cannot be setup in CEBIS).

Step 11: Step by step line item selection

- 1. Scroll to and select "Display Setting"
- 2. Select "User-defined displays".
- 3. Select "Settings".
- 4. Scroll through options and pick desired line items.




Step 10: Populate line items on CEBIS field screen

- Select "Start the work record" when starting a field.
- 2. Black background on Measuring icon shows recording in progress.









Step 13: Status of GPS

- After starting the work record, scroll over to the GPS icon.
- Visually verify that the GPS coordinates are reading.




Step 15: Stop recording Data

 Click "Stop the work record" when field is finished. <u>Important – Do not forget this step</u> <u>or to save card daily.</u>




Step 14: Verify GPS signal

Chapter 6: FAQs

Q1: Why are numbers relating to yield off on my JAGUAR?

A1: Due to a bug in the programing, CEBIS records yield in KG/AC even when it is set to LBS/AC. Therefore, you must convert KG to LBS within Ag Leader SMS or Trimble Farm Works.

Q2: Why is there data missing in spots of my field?

A2: If the GPS signal is lost, no data will record. The signal is lost every time the machine turns on/off and has a delay of up to 30 minutes.

Q3: Will the work record continue to record data when ignition is turned off?

A3: Yes, you must select stop recording to end task.

Q4: Will it record in road transport?

A4: No, the header drive must be engaged for data to record.

Q5: How should I organize crop with multiple harvests in the same year?

A5: For the commodity (Farm Works) or product (SMS) it is recommended to create one for each instance. For example, Crop A 1st cutting, Crop A 2nd cutting, Crop A 3rd cutting, etc.
